

FOLKWAYS

Folkways are a category of norm that is roughly translated to a 'social or cultural custom'. They are one of four types of norms, the others being: laws, mores, and taboos.

DEFINITION

Folkways are culturally-defined norms of etiquette that are not very serious if broken. They are mostly customary and polite. They differ from other types of norms that you might learn about in Sociology classes like taboos, mores, and laws because they tend to be less serious. They're not illegal (like laws) and often not even norms of morality (like mores).

2. Dressing Appropriately at Work
3. Wearing a School Uniform
4. Raising your Hand to Speak
5. Only having Hard Drinks after 5 PM
6. Not Spitting on the Sidewalk
